# RANDOLPH-ASHEBORO YMCA

## Mask Requirements For The Randolph-Asheboro YMCA® Effective Wednesday, November 25th at 5:00 PM

1. All staff and members need to wear masks at all times within the building. They may take them off outside if they are socially distancing 6 feet from participants.
2. Classes can be held outdoors without masks on participants or instructors as long as they are socially distanced 6 ft. from each other. They will need to wear masks while they are in the building going to class. Location of classes will be up to the discretion of the instructor of each class.
3. If a member states that they cannot wear masks due to medical reasons, the Y will not ask for a note or what the medical reason is. The Y will make a note on the members account at the front desk and put an arm band on them each time they come into the Y. They will need to wear the arm band while inside the YMCA to identify their exemption. This will prevent staff from having to constantly ask the member about wearing a mask.
4. The mask order is for cloth face coverings. Face shields are not considered a mask.
5. Rescue-ready lifeguards and instructors in the water do not wear masks. Swimmers or water participants do not wear a mask while in the water but they do need to socially distance 6 feet from others. Masks are required while on the pool deck.
6. Since this a state mandate, we as a YMCA will follow all guidelines. We will give guideline updates when the Governor speaks again on December 10th.
